

FULL SOUTH TO CUSCO

DAY 1: Lima To Paracas

6:30 - 7:00am	Depart Lima - We pick up directly from hostels and hotels. If staying in an Airbnb just email us. Your booking confirmation (ticket) will show you your exact pick-up time (depends on where you are staying!)
8:30 - 9:30am	We stop for a unique breakfast, straight from the bread ovens of MIRASUR – Enjoy some of the freshest baked bread in Peru and watch the local horses as they show the traditional dance of CABALLOS DEL PASO - yes, the horses dance!
12:00 - 1:00pm	FREE tour of the Secret Slave Tunnels - Exclusive Hop Stop at the Hacienda San Jose in Chincha to explore the underground tunnels, as well as learning about the history of the ex-sugar plantation and the tunnels that lay beneath.
2:00pm	Arrive Paracas - A beautiful small fishing town by the sea.
Things To Do	Rent quad bikes or bicycles and explore the reserve, learn how to kite surf, take a long walk on the beach and enjoy some ceviche by the sea, or familiarize yourself with local knowledge and pay a visit to the Paracas Museum.
Where To Stay	Los Frayles is a beautiful hotel with a pool, free Wi-Fi and private bathrooms for all rooms. Alternatively, if a hostel is more your scene, check out Kokopelli, which is widely believed to be the best hostel in Paracas with a swimming pool and a small bar.
Insider Tip	For those very short on time, you can take the 6am Express bus from Lima to Paracas, do the Ballestas Islands OR the National Reserve, and then take the 1pm bus from Paracas to Huacachina on the same day.

DAY 2: Paracas to Huacachina		
8:00 - 10:00am	EXTRA Ballestas Islands Tour - See the Poor Man's Galapagos and get up close and personal with wildlife such as penguins, sea lions and plenty of other animals in their natural habitat.	
What To Bring	A sun hat, windbreaker and a camera for all those perfect shots!	
11:00am	FREE Paracas National Reserve Tour - One of South America's biggest protected desert reserves and the first of its kind in Peru.	
What You'll See	Amazing views of the desert meeting the coastline and the unique red beach made up of ruby red sand and formed by natural minerals.	
1:00pm	Depart Paracas – Meeting point at Los Frayles hotel.	
Important Note	Please arrive 15 minutes before the bus departs and be sure to bring all your luggage to the bus	
2:15pm	Arrive in Huacachina – The only desert oasis in South America.	
Important Note	Due to the size of the town, we do not pick up or drop off at hotels and hostels here. The central meeting point is Wild Rover hostel.	
4:00 - 6:00pm	EXTRA Dunebuggy/Sandboarding Tour — Fly up the slopes in a dunebuggy, and sandboard down the biggest dunes in South America	
What To Wear & Bring	Sunscreen, light clothes, sneakers and camera

DAY 3: Huacachina to Nazca to Arequipa

Depart Huacachina – Meeting point is Wild Rover Hostel.
Please arrive 15 minutes before the bus departs and be sure to bring all your luggage to the bus
FREE Pisco Vineyard Visit - Try lots of free samples of Pisco, the national drink of Peru and learn all about how it is made, from grape to bottle!
FREE Nazca Lines Viewing Tower Stop - See 3 of the mysterious and world-famous Nazca Lines for free!
Dinner stop in Nazca. Enjoy sublime local cuisine with this buffet meal. Vegetarian options are available!
Depart Nazca- snuggle up with our thick blankets as you prepare for a night on our luxury bus, a rite of passage for all travelers of Peru!

DAY 4: Arrive to Arequipa

5:30am	Arrive in Arequipa – Arguably Peru's most beautiful city, the "Ciudad Blanca" to locals, or the White City!
What To Do	Visit the famous monastery of Saint Catalina, spend some time in the second deepest canyon in the world, the Colca Canyon, indulge in the delectable cuisine of this region, or simply join a free walking tour of this beautiful city!
Traveler Tip	Arequipa is a big city with plenty to do so if you are looking to extend your travels, we recommend you add a few days here!

DAY 5: Arequipa (Colca Canyon)

3:00am - 17:30pm	EXTRA Full Day Colca Canyon Tour - The second deepest Canyon in the world.
What To Bring	Your passport, your water bottle, a warm jacket, sunglasses and your camera!
5:30pm	Return Arequipa
Note	Many travelers find that starting a 2 Day trek or tour after an overnight bus is very tiring. If you are short on time the 1-day tour option might be best for you. To do a Colca Canyon Trek requires a minimum of 3-4 days in Arequipa (you will need at least 1 day to acclimatize properly) and will depend on the option you choose (2 Day/1 Night Trek or 3 Days/2 Nights).

DAY 6: Arequipa To Puno To Cusco

5:45am	Depart Arequipa – we pick you up from hotels and hostels located in the central city zone. Be ready for pick up 20 minutes before your scheduled departure!
9:30am	FREE Lagunillas Mirador Viewpoint - Oversee the stunning Lake Titicaca with its four small islands at 4.174 m above sea level, making it the highest navigable lake in the world.
11:00am	Driver stop/ bus swap — travelers heading into Puno will hop into a smaller vehicle that will quickly and easily transport you to Puno, just an hour away!
1:00pm	Arrival in Puno - Gateway to the highest navigable lake in the world!
What To Do	Tours of Lake Titicaca and the legendary man-made floating islands, or check out the Sillustani burial towers.
Traveler Tip	The altitude here is high, so make sure to drink plenty of water and stay away from heavy food.
4:30 - 6:30pm	EXTRA Floating Islands of Uros Tour (2 hrs) - These man-made islands are home to the Uros tribe. Climb aboard and learn about the history from the locals themselves.
9:30pm	Depart Puno – pick up is from your hotels and hostels within the central city zone. Please be at your dedicated meeting point at least 15 minutes in advance.
Note	2-hour, full day and 2 day/1-night homestay Lake Titicaca Tours available. For the longer tours, be sure to update your itinerary so you can fit these in.

DAY 7: Arrive To Cusco

6:00am Arrives Cusco - Hotel/hostel drop-off

What To Do Cusco is home to the world-famous Machu Picchu citadel, but Machu Picchu is not the

only thing that will captivate you. Spend time scaling the Rainbow Mountain, or lose yourself in history in the Sacsayhuaman fortress. There are thousands of incredible
